## **Required Tools:**

- Level
- Pencil
- Measuring Tape
- Utility Knife
- Saw (Circular, Table Saw, or Jigsaw)
- 1 ½" black flat-head screws
- Electric Drill or Screwdriver

## **Preparation:**

- Prior to installation, wall panels must be acclimated for all high-humidity environments.
  Allow a minimum of 48 hours for panels to acclimate at the location where you are installing them. Do not install in any area with excessive moisture such as bathrooms.
- Remove all accessories, moldings, light switches and electrical outlets from the wall where the product is going to be installed.
- Make sure that the surface of the wall is even. 3/8" thick plywood can be installed over the drywall if the wall is in poor condition.
- Remove any loose paint with a painter's knife.

## Installation Instructions:

- 1. Find the level line in the center of the wall (never use floor or ceiling lines, or side walls for installation).
- 2. Attach the panels on the wall by drilling 1 ½" screws through the black felt and into the wall. Use at least 6 screws per panel, securing the corners and middle of each panel to the wall.
- 3. Make sure that the felt side from one panel is flush with the wood side of the previous one so that the gap between the slats stays uniform.
- 4. Along the vertical edge of the wall, cut the slats by using a utility knife on the felt backing to adjust the width.
- 5. To adjust the height of the panels, use a pencil and a level to mark the line where you want to cut, then use a saw and cut along line.
